509 Registered Voters were polled between December 12th and 16th of 2008. Of the 509 registered voters, 28.5% were registered democrats and 51.7% were registered Republicans with the remaining percentages being either non affiliated with a party or registered with a third party.

The Polling results clearly show that the following:

- 73.7% were likely to support a constitutional amendment to protect marriage between one man and one woman. 13.4% were unlikely to support a constitutional amendment to protect marriage.
- 82.9% believed that the definition of marriage should be protected for future generations. As opposed to 6% who said no.
- 78% of voters polled believe that voters should decide the definition of marriage instead of judges vs. 7.86% who do not believe so.

Conclusions:

- Wyoming Voters firmly support the constitutional amendment to protect marriage.
- Wyoming Voters firmly support protecting marriage for future generations.
- Wyoming Voters firmly support their right to decide how Wyoming defines marriage.

For these reasons Wyoming Family Institute will continue to inform voters across the state about the constitutional amendment and the process it makes through the legislative session.
